

Barkdaull Faulk Elementary School Uniform/Dress Code Policy 2017-2018



NAVY BLUE OR KHAKI pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers
POLO STYLE SHIRT: Navy Blue, Light Blue or White
BELT: Navy, Black, or Dark Brown preferred

**Spirit shirts may be worn ONLY on Fridays with jeans for students who have maintained a(n) "A or B" average in conduct or on designated days.

General Guidelines

- Any student coming to school and/or class out of uniform will be subject to the consequences as set forth by this school uniform policy.
- All clothing must be appropriately sized; no over-sized or undersized clothing.
- All clothing must be properly worn (for example--shirts tucked in, shoes tied, Velcro straps on shoes properly fastened, and pants legs unrolled).
- **Belts are required for all students' grades K-6.**
- T-shirts or undergarments should be free of writing, designs, etc. Garments advertising liquor and tobacco products, offensive messages, or offensive language shall not be allowed. Gang related clothing is prohibited.
- No heavy coats are allowed to be worn inside the school building.
- **Velcro fastened shoes are encouraged for students in grades Pre-K4- 1st grade.**

VIOLATIONS:

Failure to comply with the above stated dress code will result in the following:

1st Violation: Teacher/Student Conference

2nd Violation: Call to Parent to notify of uniform violation. Parent shall bring uniform item to student.

3rd Violation: Discipline Referral to Office

4th Violation: Parent Conference at School- The school will reissue a copy of the dress code.

5th Violation: Parent Conference at school with Social Worker present to address the needs of Student and family.

6th Violation: 1 Day Suspension
