**School Uniform /  
Dress Code**

**Bottoms:** Navy Blue or Khaki Pants, shorts jumpers or skirts

**Polo Style Shirts:** Navy Blue, Light Blue or white

**Fridays:** Student with an A or B in conduct for the previous week may wear a BFE spirit shirt and jean. Shirts can be purchased in the front office.

**Belts must be worn on all pants with loops.**

Spirit shirts may only be worn on Fridays with jeans for students who have maintained a (n) "A" or "B" average in conduct or on designated days.



**General Guidelines:**

- Any student coming to school and/or class out of uniform will be subjected to the consequences as set forth by this school uniform policy.
- All clothing must be appropriately sized; no over-sized or undersized clothing.
- All clothing must be properly worn (shirts tucked in, shoes tied, Velcro straps on shoes properly fastened, and pant legs unrolled).
- Belts are required for all students' grade K- 6<sup>th</sup>.
- T-shirts or under garments should be free of writing, designs, etc. Garments advertising alcohol, tobacco products, or offensive language shall not be allowed. Gang related clothing is prohibited.
- No heavy coats are allowed to be worn inside the building.
- Velcro shoes are encouraged for students Pre-K- 1<sup>st</sup> Grade

**Dress Code Violation:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Violation:** Dress code mailed home to parent.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Violation:** Teacher/Student conference

**3<sup>rd</sup> Violation:** call parent to notify of uniform violation. Parent will bring proper attire to student.

**4<sup>th</sup> Violation:** Loss of privileges

**5<sup>th</sup> Violation:** Parent conference at school- The school will reissue a copy of the dress code.

**6<sup>th</sup> Violation:** Parent conference at the school with Social Worker present to address the needs of student and family.

**7<sup>th</sup> Violation:** Referral to office and loss of privileges.
